Job Description

Camp Counselors are an important part of the Camp Loads of Fun team. As a counselor you will connect with children to foster a fun and safe camp experience. This is a completely outdoor day camp that includes swimming, sports, games, crafts, and more. We are located at the beautiful Herbert I Johnson Recreation fields. Additionally, Camp Loads of Fun occasionally goes on field trips to local state parks or visits the Killington Adventure Center, as well as the adjacent town library for special programs.

About the Team

A municipal entity, the Department of Parks and Recreation offers a variety of outdoor summer day camps that are affordable and accessible to the community. Our philosophy of camp is to create a summer experience filled with fun and exploration. Our counselors provide a safe space for children build independence, character, and lifetime memories.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Supervise children as they play during all scheduled activities.
2. Build rapport with children within your group.
3. Make sure each child is signed-in and/or signed-out daily.
4. Bring and pick up children to swim lessons, specialty camps, or swim team.
5. Execute provided daily schedule including field games, crafts, and other fun activities.
6. Supervise children on field trips to state parks, the Sherburne Library, or the Killington Adventure Center.
7. Communicate well with others, including with co-counselors and parents.
8. Be adaptable to changes during the summer months due to weather and/or numbers of campers.
9. Have a reliable mode of transportation.
10. Able to multi-task and supervise multiple children in a group.
11. Maintain your camp area.
12. Reports to the camp director.

Qualifications

- CPR/First Aid certified preferred, but not required
- Experience working with school age children
- Must pass a background check
- At least 18 years of age
- Ability to be outdoors, on feet most of the day and walk distances between recreation facilities
