

Head Swim Coach

Job Description

The Killington Sharks swim team is accepting applications for Head Swim Coach for the 2023 summer season.

The Killington Sharks offer training and practice groups for swimmers of 5 to 18 years old and of all ability levels. It is the goal of the Killington Sharks to offer age specific training geared towards challenging each individual and developing everyone to the best of their abilities.

The Head Swim Coach is responsible for managing and directing the swim team programs including the Pre-Senior Group (5-10 year old) and the Senior Group (11-18 year old). The Head Swim Coach will coordinate all practices and activities related to swim meets and provide team members with individual instruction tailored to the needs and skill abilities of each individual. The Head Swim Coach will report to the Director of Parks and Recreation.

About the Team

The Killington Sharks swim team is a seasonal recreation team practicing out of the Town of Killington's Johnson Recreation Center outdoor pool. It is part of the Southern Vermont Swim League and the Vermont Swim Association.

Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Plan and lead all practices
- 2. Attend all home and away meets and plan line-ups
- 3. Work to create an environment of teaching and learning among swimmers and all coaches/parent volunteers
- 4. Design and execute workouts to meet the individual needs of swimmers, improving techniques and speed
- 5. Maintain a sense of professionalism when dealing with Killington Sharks parents, swimmers, volunteers & coaches.

Qualifications

- Previous swim team coaching experience preferred but not required
- Knowledge and experience teaching swimming to a variety of abilities and levels preferred
- Strong communication skills
- Willingness to work outside in all weather conditions for extended periods of time
- Proof of Lifeguard, First Aid, and CPR training preferred
- Must pass a background check

Practice schedule: Practices occur weekdays beginning June 8 and run from 8 AM to 10:15 AM, with exception of the first week of practice, which occurs in the evening.
