Job Description

Lifeguards ensure the safe operation of the Herbert I. Johnson Recreation Pool and allow visitors to have an enjoyable experience. A positive attitude and good customer service are a must at the Johnson Rec Pool!

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Evenly enforce and adhere to all rules and regulations of the pool. Guards set the example for the community.
2. Adhere to best practices including one guard at check-in, two or more guards in chairs during operating hours, at least one guard selling concessions, and periodically check the facilities for cleanliness.
3. Constantly be on the lookout for accidents occurring in the water, on the deck, or on the diving board.
4. Check in patrons, distinguish between residents and non-residents, and record and provide pool passes.
5. Guards are responsible for the cleanliness of the pool and are expected to proactively remove all clutter, trash, and other foreign objects as well as work cooperatively with other guards in this process. Tasks include vacuuming the pool, hosing, disinfecting, sweeping, and mopping. Guards are also responsible for completing and signing a daily task sheet.
6. Maintain the swimming pool deck and keep skimmers clean.
7. Sell and record concession sales.
8. Maintain ping pong room and equipment rentals.
9. Complete all daily reports and cash out sheets.

Qualifications

- American Red Cross Lifeguarding Certification and CPR/First aid Certification
- Ability to work with the public
